For over twenty years, Several Sources Foundation has been assisting young women who have become pregnant, and have nowhere else to turn.

Several Sources Foundation provides a home through the pregnancy and for up to a year after the baby is born. We provide love, counseling, parenting and other classes, and to the extent possible- job training and education.

With the assistance of a matching grant from the Brandywine Foundation, we will be able to better help those women with the greatest potential to help themselves.

For every dollar you give, the Grant will provide matching funds up to \$100,000 per year. The Grant creates a fund dedicated to educational and job training assistance including partial scholarships, child care, housing and transportation for the candidates selected by and mentored by Several Sources Foundation. ## Did you know...

An unskilled worker who is lucky enough to find work at \$7.00 per hour earns about \$14,500 per year with virtually no benefits and limited prospects for advancement.



Even a modest apartment in northern NJ costs upwards of \$800 per month.

Day care, which is needed so mom can work, costs at least \$750 per month. After allowing for some possible County benefits, the cost is still over \$250.

Tuition is more expensive than you might think:

- Medical Office Assistant—\$10,950
- Licensed Practical Nurse—\$14,875
- Medical Billing & Coding—\$7,775
- Medical Office Specialist, Sonography—\$14,975
- plus Externship—\$2,100
- Administrative Assistant—\$16,200
- Jr. Accountant—\$32,400
